The Fort Sam Houston Memorial Services Detachment (MSD) is an all-volunteer group composed of more than 84 veterans who perform military honors ceremonies at funerals for United States military veterans at the Fort Sam Houston National Cemetery. The origin of the Memorial Services Detachment relates back to the late 1980's when due to budget cutbacks, a shortage of active duty personnel, and a growing number of military veteran interment services, the Pentagon found it necessary to restrict full military burial honors to persons dying while on active duty, Medal of Honor recipients and those fully retired. Veterans who have not retired from the military are no longer entitled to full military burial honors.

In response to those mandates, a group of San Antonio volunteers, recognizing the disappointment of the families of deceased veterans, set about planning and training to provide full burial honors for interment ceremonies at the Fort Sam Houston National Cemetery at no cost to the families. Each day, regardless of the weather, an honor guard from the MSD presides at each service to provide the traditional three volleys of rifle fire and the sound of "Taps" that final act of respect for those who have served this great nation.

It should be noted that we not only provide honors for veterans who are no longer entitled to full military burial honors, but we also back up the active military services when their honor guards are not available. We also provide services on occasions when families and the funeral homes do not make prior arrangements with the military services branches.

Jim also is a member of The Fort Sam Houston MSD.
